Objectifs:

To provide students with exercises and practical applications of what has been discussed in the Introduction to English Linguistics lectures.

Contenu:

This course offers an introduction to the scientific study of language. We will discuss what general facts about language have been discovered, how language differs from animal communication systems, how different linguistic structures can be analyzed and how linguistic forms convey meaning.

Forme de l'évaluation:

The workshop will be graded based on the following:

Participation (25%)

- This entails maintaining regular attendance and participation in the course activities.

Homework Assignments (75%)

- Assignments will be made available on Claroline and students will be expected to upload their completed assignments on the date indicated.

Rattrapages

- In order to earn a passing grade, students need to achieve an overall average of a 4 in all the categories explained above . A failing grade incurs a rattrapage of a written essay (5,000 words), on a linguistic topic assigned by the instructor.
